IAI in collaboration with the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC) are organizing a virtual international webinar “**Optimizing Sustainability Governance through a Single Set of High-Quality Global Sustainability Reporting Standards**” on 12 April 2022. As a member of the B20 Integrity & Compliance Task Force, IAI is honored to have the B20's support to recognize the webinar as part of the B20 Integrity & Compliance Task Force Side Event, as initiated by the Indonesian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KADIN). This webinar is part of a series of three B20 side events that will be organized by IAI and IFAC in 2022.

In a global and interconnected world, there is an urgent call for the leaders of the G20 and business community to act on promoting sustainable governance in business to support Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) initiatives.
