#### **VISA AND INDONESIA ARRIVAL CARD**

For many nationalities, Indonesia offers a Visa on Arrival (VOA) or an Electronic Visa on Arrival (e-VOA) for tourism and other short-term purposes. You can either obtain the visa upon arrival at a designated immigration counter or apply for the e-VOA online beforehand to save time.

#### About the Visa on Arrival (VOA / e-VOA)

Validity	The visa is valid for 30 days and can be extended once for an additional
	30 days, for a maximum total stay of 60 days. After 60 days, you must
	leave the country.
Cost	The visa fee is IDR 500,000 (around \$35 USD).
Purpose	The VOA is for single-entry visits for tourism, business meetings,
	purchasing goods, or transit. It is not for employment or running a
	business.



Single-entry visa	The VOA becomes invalid if you leave Indonesia. To re-enter, you would
	need to apply for a new visa
How to get a VOA	<ol> <li>Upon arrival (VOA): You can purchase the visa at a dedicated counter in the arrival hall of a major international airport or seaport. Payment can be made with a credit card or cash (in Indonesian Rupiah, USD, EUR, AUD, or GBP).</li> <li>Online beforehand (e-VOA): For a faster process, you can apply for an e-VOA on the official Indonesian immigration website, evisa.imigrasi.go.id, before your trip. This allows you to skip the queue upon arrival and may enable the use of e-gates if you have a biometric passport.</li> </ol>

Arrival Card	<ul> <li>Indonesia has introduced a unified digital portal, named "All Indonesia", to streamline immigration, customs, and health procedures into a single form, replacing multiple separate processes like SATUSEHAT (health declaration) and e-CD (customs declaration) online forms.</li> <li>1. Travelers fill out this form within 3 days (ideally 72 hours) prior to arrival</li> <li>2. The process takes about 2.5 minutes to complete</li> <li>3. Upon submission, a QR code is generated and sent via email, which must be presented to immigration/customs upon arrival</li> <li>4. It's free of charge</li> <li>Please complete your Arrival Card before entering Indonesia by filling out the required information.</li> </ul>

#### **ACCESS TO JAKARTA**

#### Soekarno-Hatta Airport to the city

Most international flights arrive at the Terminal 3 at Soekarno-Hatta Airport, airlines like Singapore Airlines, Emirates, Qatar Airways, and Turkish Airlines operate from this terminal. Some others flights are also arrived at Terminal 3 at Soekarno-Hatta Airport.

#### Meter Taxi (Bluebird or Silverbird-Premium)

CGK Terminal 3 to Central Jakarta: IDR 200,000 – 350,000 (depending on traffic and time of day) with toll fee IDR 27,000, the estimate price is USD 21.

Payment can be done by cash during or by QRIS Feature.

	<b>Silver Bird (Executive Taxi</b> is a premium taxi service offering luxury sedans or Alphard for those seeking extra comfort.
	Payment can be done by cash during or by QRIS Feature or put your credit card on bluebird apps.

Grab/Gojek	If you're traveling around Jakarta, Gojek and Grab are the two most convenient ride-hailing apps. Easy to book through the app, with options for car or motorbike rides.
	Cashless payments available (GoPay, OVO, cards, QRIS).
	Efficient in traffic — motorbikes (GoRide / GrabBike) are great for bypassing Jakarta's heavy congestion. If you're carrying luggage or traveling in a group → GrabCar / GoCar is better.



	Extra services — both apps also offer food delivery, shopping, and courier services.
	You may download the apps via Appstore or Google Playstore
MRT Jakarta	The Jakarta MRT (Mass Rapid Transit) is the city's first modern subway system, designed to ease traffic congestion and provide efficient public transportation.
	Operating Hours: approx. 05:00 – 24:00, with trains every 5–10 minutes.
	Payment Options for MRT Jakarta: Bank-issued prepaid cards (e-money), QRIS Payment, or Single Trip Ticket (STT) at the vending machine.
