





Sharia Accounting Certification Examination (USAS)

The Sharia Accounting Certification Examination (USAS) is IAI's contribution to strengthening the national sharia economy by enhancing the competencies of professionals in preparing financial reports for sharia-based transactions. USAS is part of IAI's strategy to advance sharia accounting knowledge and expertise in response to the evolving landscape and challenges of the sharia industry in Indonesia. The USAS is structured in three levels: Elementary, Intermediate, and Advanced.



Financial Accounting Standards Certification Examination (USPSAK)

IAI launched the USPSAK (Financial Accounting Standards Certification Examination) to meet the demand for qualified human capital in preparing financial reports based on Indonesian Financial Accounting Standards (PSAK). Successful participants are awarded the designation Certified PSAK (CPSAK) and are required to maintain their competencies through Continuing Professional Education (CPE).





Government Accounting Certifications: US-CGAA & US-CGAE

The former Government Accounting Expert Certification (USAAP) has evolved into two certifications:

Certified Government Accounting Associate (US-CGAA) & Certified Government Expert (US-CGAE)

The US-CGAE is divided into Level 1 and Level 2 and applies to both central and local government contexts. These certifications aim to enhance the competencies of government accountants in financial reporting across all levels of government.



Certificate in Accounting, Finance & Business (CAFB)

The Certificate in Accounting, Finance & Business (CAFB) was developed by IAI as the foundational level for the Chartered Accountant (CA) Indonesia designation. CAFB aligns with global standards and best practices. With CAFB, IAI now offers a complete pathway from foundation to professional certification.


